

## EXTENDED ERASMUS UNIVERSITY CHARTER

The participation of IES Torres Villarroel in these programs was greatly successful and with important benefits for the school.

By taking part in an Erasmus program our school intends to develop a model of global education within the European Union. At the same time we fulfill one of the aims of the Treaty of the Union: to promote the movement of people in the different countries. In our case this would be achieved through student exchange programs.

Main Aims:

- To develop the practical training of students and its practical recognition.
- To increase the mobility of students and facilitate their incorporation to the work market.
- To promote cultural exchanges.
- To increase international contacts through agreements with organizations related to the Graphic Arts.
- To create the appropriate conditions to favour international projection of our school.

The Erasmus program is, thus, an important tool in promoting open doors for our students and a great help for cooperation among different European entities or organizations (specially those working in the Graphic Arts area).

IES Torres Villarroel will advertise its participation in the Erasmus program through different media: school web page, social networks, school magazine, posters and any other publishing media available to school. The school will also engage in lectures to promote the program.

Our school is located in one of the most populated and diverse neighborhoods in Salamanca. Students comprise a great variety. So integration is the spine of all our programs. Moreover, our school is reference for students with auditory discapacitiy and has, since 2008, an interpreter in our staff.

Regarding finances, we will inform students about the different scholarships available in order to participate in the program. We will also inform and help look for accommodation as well as keep the students informed about the cultural activities. This information will be given to students through the Erasmus coordinator and the Servicio de Orientación Universitaria at the University of Salamanca.

The tutor will analyze the different work programs, stating the requirements in the different places. These programs will be offered to all those students who meet the criteria. If there were more than one candidate for the same program, there will be a process of selection, considering aptitude and suitability for the position.

Follow-up will be done through weekly reports containing the activities of that week. These reports will be signed by the tutor in the school and will be sent by e-mail to the tutor in our school.

E-mail and telephone will be available for solving problems and answering questions.

Final assessment will consist of a final report written by the student (supervised by the tutor), and another report by the teacher in charge of the student (the form for this report will be drawn up by our school). Finally, the student will make an oral presentation when he/she gets back to our school. This presentation can be used as a future reference for advertising the Erasmus program.

The experience acquired through the Erasmus program will be admitted as "Módulo de Formación en Centro de Trabajo" in his/her studies.

All of this will be assessed at the end of the practical training.

The curriculum of our studies is being renewed this year, and it will be updated according to the European Union requirements and adapted to the New Information Technologies.

Once this revision is finished the training-work program will be recognized with 6 ECTS credits.
